

Camp Rules

- Campers and visitors must register upon arrival and pay appropriate fees.
- Check-out time is 1:00 pm. If you wish to stay longer, you must receive permission from the campground owner.
- No more than two vehicles per campsite. Additional parking is available at the Pavilion, Rec Hall or ask the campground owner where you might park.
- **Quiet time is 10:00 pm to 8:00 am. This rule will be strictly enforced.**
- No visitors will be allowed to enter the campground after 10:00 pm. All visitors must be out of camp by 11:00 pm, otherwise they will be charged an overnight fee.
- Recreation Hall will be closed at 10:00 pm each night.
- Parents are responsible for their children's behavior. Curfew for children under the age of 18 is 10:00 pm, unless accompanied by a parent or another responsible adult over age 21.
- **PLEASE RESPECT PRIVACY OF OTHERS.**
- Alcoholic beverages *are* permitted in camp; however, Pennsylvania state laws must be obeyed. Underage drinking will not be tolerated. Anyone violating the alcohol policy will cause eviction from the campground of the entire party of that site.
- All pets must be leashed or under close control at all times. You must clean up after your pets. Pets must not be left unattended at your campsite. Pets which are house-trained are allowed in rustic cabins only. **No pets allowed in full-service cabins (White Tail and Black Bear Lodges).**
- All small children must be supervised in rest rooms. Loitering in rest room buildings is not permitted.
- Each site is equipped with a fire ring. **Fire rings are not to be moved!**
- Campfires must be attended at all times, and must be extinguished before leaving camp or retiring for the night.
- No cutting of standing trees, dead or alive, for any purpose. Downed brush or trees, in your immediate vicinity or campsite, may be gathered for firewood. Do not take firewood from other campsites.
- Please keep sites clean at all times.
- Please dispose of trash, including cigarette butts, properly.
- **Campground speed limit is 10 mph, and will be strictly enforced.** Please observe all stop signs and one-way signs. Watch out for children playing or riding bicycles.
- Children riding bicycles in camp must wear safety equipment in accordance with the laws of Pennsylvania, and obey the rules of the road.
- Use of all terrain vehicles (ATVs) or similar vehicles is not permitted in camp without special permission from the campground owner.
- No shooting of fireworks, firearms or bows and arrows on campground property.
- Do not pick plants, flowers or disturb wildlife.
- Bears have been seen in camp and are dangerous animals. Do not feed or approach them. Please abide by the warnings posted throughout camp.
- No washing of pots, pans, etc, in restrooms.
- No washing of vehicles, including campers, in campground.
- No throwing stones or other objects in campground.
- Anyone defacing or destroying campground property, acting in an illegal manner, or otherwise failing to obey campground rules will be evicted from the campground.
- The campground reserves the right to refuse service to anyone deemed acting in an inappropriate manner, and will ask that person(s) to leave immediately, with no refund.
- Refunds will not be given to parties evicted from the campground.

Charges for additional persons are as follows:

Persons under age 5 - free

Persons age 15 and over - \$4.00 per night

Daily visitors are also charged \$2.00

Daily onsite camper storage: plugged-in - \$5.00/ not plugged-in - \$3.00

White Tail Lodge* (sleeps 6 w/Bathroom) \$135.00

Black Bear Lodge* (sleeps 6 w/Bathroom) \$135.00

Trapper Lodge (sleeps 6-8) \$90.00

New Hemlock Haven Cabin (sleeps 2-4) \$80.00

Poolside Cabin (sleeps 2-4) \$80.00

Delaware Cabin (sleeps 2) \$70.00

Zook Cabin (sleeps 2) \$70.00

Rates are based on a 2-night stay.

Single nights require a \$15.00 premium, \$25.00 for WT or BB Lodge

There is a 3-night minimum stay on Holiday weekends and a 2-night minimum stay on PSU football home game weekends.

**No Pets or Smoking allowed in White Tail or Black Bear Lodge*

Specials (RV, Camper, Tent or Cabin)

Weekly Rate - 7 nights for the price of 6.

Cabin Special - 7 nights for the price of 5.

Monthly Rate - 28 nights (4 weeks) \$600.

Multiple months - ask for special rate.

Yearly Sites available, ask for information.

Organized Youth Group Tent Camping* \$25.00 flat fee
plus \$1.00 per person per night

*For example, scout or church youth groups.

Camper Information

All sites and cabins include:

- A picnic table, fire ring and trash can.
- Use of regular camp recreational facilities.
- Use of conveniently located bathhouses, with flush toilets and hot showers.
- Use of pool between Memorial Day and Labor Day.
- RV and camper sites include water and electric hook-ups.
- Tent sites do not include electric, but do have water nearby.

All camp facilities (except the pool) are open during the regular camping season, mid-April through mid-October. Camping is available during the off-season, although camp facilities are limited. Please check with campground owners for specific details.

All cabins include:

- Some basic kitchen equipment like a microwave*, coffeemaker, pots, pans and dishes. You may want to bring some of your own necessities.
 - Mattresses, you will need to bring your own bedding and pillows.
- *(Except Delaware Cabin)

Check-in

- All campers are required to check in at office upon their arrival.
- Check-in time after 3 pm.*
- Check-out time before 1 pm.*
- If available, Early Check-in (prior to 3:00 pm) and Late Check-out (after 1:00 pm), @ a cost of \$5.00 per hour.
- * Other arrangements may be made, please ask!

Visitors

- All visitors, at any time of year, are required to check in at office upon arrival.
- Campers are responsible for making sure their visitors' fees are paid.

Electric Usage

- We encourage campers to be moderate in their electric use.
- RV site rentals include use of no more than two strings of low wattage patio lights.
- All daytime exterior lighting is prohibited.
- Additional charges are required for the use of these appliances:

<u>Electric heat or AC</u>	<u>\$5.00 per day</u>
<u>Electric hot water heater</u>	<u>\$5.00 per day</u>

Waste Disposal

- Trash cans and bags are provided for your use.
- Ashes (such as campfire ashes) should be left in fire ring, for disposal by campground owner.
- RV site rentals include free use of dump stations.
- On-site sewage and dishwater pick-up is available for a fee of \$15.00.
- Sewage will not be handled if deodorant/sanitizer is not used, or if liquid is insufficient to permit solids to be dumped out. **DO NOT PLACE COARSE PAPER TOWELS OR TAMPONS IN TOILETS.** These items will damage disposal pump and necessitate an additional \$25.00 fee payable by camper.
